



BOOTH FEE:

- \$25 for each day --- \$50 for the full weekend --- Non-profit Organizations \$10 a day
- Power available upon request at no additional charge
- All chamber members free
- Please try to have application and Fees in before June 2, 2008
- Sorry, there will be no refunds after June 6, 2008

LOCATION:

- OUTDOORS along Main Street, downtown Brewster

BOOTH SPACE:

- Vendors will be assigned a 10'x12' space (THIS INCLUDES STORAGE SPACE)
- Vendors must supply their own set-up.
- Vendors MUST fit all of their merchandise within allotted space.
- If you request or use extra space, we will look at your booth at set-up to decide whether you can use that space and if any other charges will be incurred.
- All booth spots will be assigned on a first come-first served basis by a Chamber Official. You must accept the spot given.
- Electrical outlets are available. Those requesting power will need a 50 ft., 3-wire conductor cord.

MERCHANDISE:

- Vendors are responsible for claiming Washington State Sales Tax (which is 8%).
- The following work is NOT ACCEPTABLE:
 - Real Guns of any kind
 - Inappropriate adult material
 - Hazardous items
- The Brewster Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to close booths not adhering to these regulations.

DAYS & HOURS OF OPERATION:

- Begins Friday June 13th and ends Sunday June 15th
- Booths must be ready to open by 2 pm on Friday, June 13th
- All vendors are asked to be open no later than 2 pm on Friday and open at least until 8 pm Friday and Saturday, and 10 am up to 2 pm on Sunday.
- Teardown may begin at 12 pm on Sunday if necessary

CHECK-IN:

- You may show up as early as 7 am on Friday
- No booth will be allowed to set-up prior to check-in time without a chamber official approval. no vehicles are allowed to block traffic at anytime, if you do block traffic you will be towed. Please be courteous to the concessionaires and pedestrians as you set-up and unload your merchandise.

SECURITY:

- Limited overnight security will be provided, however your booth remains YOUR RESPONSIBILITY!
- Neither the Brewster Chamber of Commerce nor the City of Brewster assumes responsibility for injury to persons, or loss or damage to any property of the vendors, including theft.

RESTRICTIONS:

- Vendors are not allowed to "ROVE" with their merchandise at anytime.
- If Vendors leave early, they will not receive a refund
- Alcoholic beverages, loud music, television, and "hawking" will not be allowed in the vicinity of your booth.
- The Chamber reserves the right to remove any work it does not consider suitable for a general audience of adult and children.
- You are required to locate your own all-day parking, however some parking will be provided.
- The Brewster Chamber of Commerce will remove from the show anyone failing to cooperate with Chamber Officials and/or volunteers or failing to comply with the rules and policies.
